Bottled Beers:	Our 'House' ale is Butcombe's Brunel, a superb 5% IPA, first bottled in January 2006 to celebrate Brunel's 200 th birthday. The great engineer would have approved of the craftsmanship. We usually have a selection of other ale.	2.85
Draught:	With a little encouragement we are only too happy to arrange for bitter on draught. We usually recommend an ale from one of our three local breweries:	£2.50
Tom Newman:	The of Tom's – there are also Woolly Mammoth and Cave Bear!	
Wolvers Ale	A fine all year round ale, with a rich after taste that all real ale enthusiasts will immediately love.	4.1%
Red Stag	A well balanced, amber-red coloured, dry bitter with fruity, slightly spicy and citrus notes. Available in autumn	3.6%
Bite IPA	A light refreshing and hoppy beer with a spicy hop finish with a subtle complex maltiness.	4.6%
Butcombe:	As well as Brunel IPA on draught during the winter, Butcombe offer a good session beer as well as Butcombe Blond – a bit like Budweiser Budvar – and Butcombe Gold – using only English malt and Fruggles hops.	5.0% 4/0% 4.3% 4.7%
